ADVERBS OF FREQUENCY



%	Adverb of Frequency	Example
100%	Always	I always study after class
90%	Usually	I usually walk to work
80%	Normally / Generally	I normally get good marks
70%	Often / Frequently	I often read in bed at night
50%	Sometimes	I sometimes sing in the shower
30%	Occasionally	I occasionally go to bed late
10%	Seldom	I seldom put salt on my food
5%	Hardly ever / Rarely	I hardly ever get angry
0%	Never	Vegetarians never eat meat

Subject + Adverb + Main Verb Daniel always passes his exams.	Subject + BE + Adverb He is always happy.
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HOW OFTEN?

ADVERBS OF DEFINITE FREQUENCY



How often? = I want to know the frequency

Example: How often do you brush your teeth?

Number + Times	A	Time Period
Once*	a	day <small>SINGULAR NOUN</small>
Twice*	a	week
Three times	a	month
Four times	a	year

Time Period
daily
weekly
monthly
annually

EVERY	Number	Time Period
Every	two	days <small>PLURAL NOUN</small>
Every	three	weeks
Every	four	months

EVERY	Time Period
Every	day <small>SINGULAR NOUN</small>
Every	week
Every	month

- She visits the dentist twice a year.
- He goes to the gym three times a week.
- I call her daily to make sure she is fine.
- There is a leap day every four years.
- We pay our mortgage every month.

* one time	✗
once	✓
two times	✗
twice	✓

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HOW OFTEN..... ?

HOW OFTEN **DO** YOU / THEY /WE + VERB?

I/WE/THEY (ALWAYS/USUALLY/OFTEN/SOMETIMES/NEVER) + VERB

HOW OFTEN **DOES** SHE/HE + VERB.....?

HE /SHE (ALWAYS/USUALLY/OFTEN/ SOMETIMES/NEVER) + VERB + **S**

EXAMPLES:

- How often do your parents tidy your bedroom?
They never tidy my bedroom.
- How often does your friend take notes in class?
- He/ She often take **S** notes in class.

YES/ NO QUESTIONS :

DO YOU/THEY/WE + FREQUENCY ADVERBS + VERB +?

YES I /YOU/WE/THEY DO.

NO I/YOU/WE/THEY DON'T.

DOES HE/SHE + FREQUENCY ADVERBS + VERB +?

YES HE/SHE DOES.

NO HE/SHE DOESN'T.

EXAMPLES:

- Do you usually arrive on time?
- Yes I do. / No, I don't.

- Does your dad take out the rubbish?
- Yes he does. / No, he doesn't.
