Session 6



There are some ways to ask questions about the past

And one of them is using “wh” questions:

1. Where did you ...

We use it to ask about a place

For example:

Where did you go last week?

Where did you put your phone?

2. When did you ...

Use it to ask about time of what something happened.

Example:

When did you play football?

When did he go to the park?

3. Who did ...

We use it to ask about people

For example:

Who did you visit?

Who did he play with?

4. What did ...

We use it to ask about general things

For example:

What did she do yesterday?

What did he eat last week?

And pay attention that for answering the questions about past, you should use simple past.

Where did she go yesterday?

She **go** to the park.

Not correct

Where did she go yesterday?

She **went** to the park.

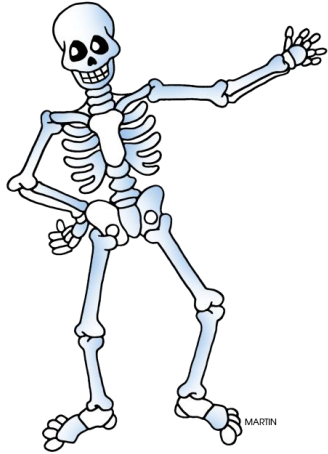
correct

Tip:

“Wh” questions are open questions.
That means you shouldn't answer them
with yes or no.

You should give long answers.

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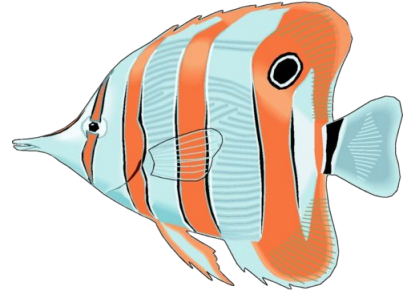
Skeleton



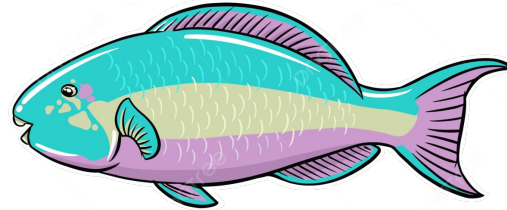
Sea horse
