Describing people

Until now you have learned to talk about people using “comparative” and “superlative” adjectives.

Comparative:

He's taller than me. (using **er** for short adjectives)

She's **more** intelligent than his friend (using **more** before long adjectives that have more than 2 syllables)

Superlative :

She's the kindest girl in our class. (using **the** and **est** for short adjectives)

She's **the most** beautiful girl that i know. (using **the most** before long adjectives)

Describing extra information

If you wanna give more information about people. You can use “too” and “also”.

Use also before the second adjective (the extra information)

She's very kind. She's **also** helpful.

Tom is tall. He's **also** fat.

Use too after the second adjective.

Sarah is very sporty. She's smart **too**.

John is intelligent. He's kind **too**.
