Litter



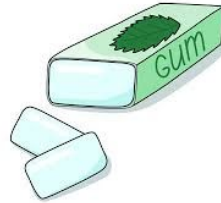
Respect: when you're nice to someone and you don't say bad things to them

Where is the cup?

Where is the crayon?

What color is Zack's hair?

What color is Oscar's shirt?

What can you see in the classroom?

Who is biting the pencil?

Who is laughing?

Who is behind the door?

When you see **doing** in a question, your answer should have **ing** too

For example:

What are you doing?  
**I am reading a book.**

You shouldn't say:  
**I am read a book.**  
**I read book.**  
**I reading book.**

# Grammar

When you want to talk about something you say “this” and “that”

Affirmative

**This** is a pen.      **This** is a book.

**That** is a rock.      **That** is a shirt.

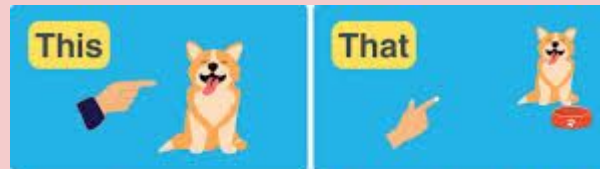
Negative

**This** isn't a car.      **This** isn't a ruler

**That** isn't a tree.      **That** isn't a chair.

**This** for the things that are near you.

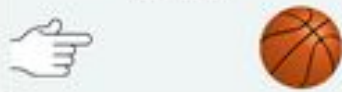
**That** for the things that are far away from you
