2 main types animals

Wild: the animals that live freely in jungle and we can't control them. Like lion, wolf, giraffe, elephant, zebra

Domestic: the animals that can live with us and don't hurt us

Domestic



1. They are **safe** to be around.
2. They usually live in the farm.
3. They don't **bite** you when you play with them.

Bite : use teeth to cut something

Safe: if an animal is safe, it doesn't hurt you.

Wild

1. They're usually free in **nature**.
2. **Humans** can't control them easily.
3. They are **dangerous**.



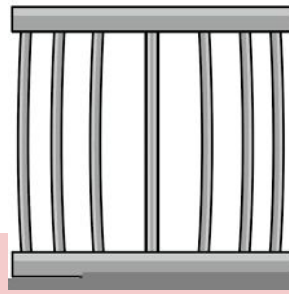
Nature: the place of living of animals and plants.

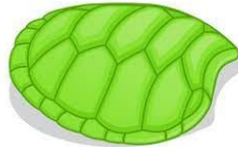
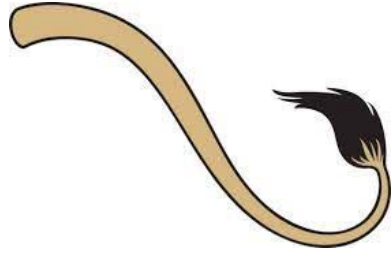
