High amount	A lot of / much	A lot of / many

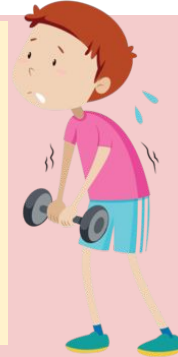
Junk food: like fast food and pizza

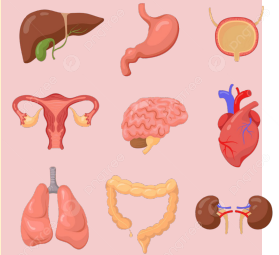

Produce Aisle: Fresh fruits and vegetables.

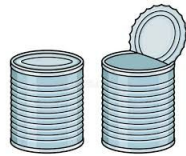
Dairy Aisle: Milk, cheese, yogurt, and other dairy products.

Meat Aisle: Fresh and packaged meats.

Seafood Aisle: Fresh and frozen fish and seafood.

Frozen Foods Aisle: Frozen meals, veggies, and ice cream.

Canned Goods Aisle: Soup, beans, vegetables, and fruits in cans.



Snacks and Candy Aisle: Chips, cookies, and sweets.

Beverages Aisle: Drinks, juices, and bottled water.

Expressing What You Are Looking For

Phrases:

“I’m looking for...”

“Do you have...?”

“I need...”

“Can you show me...?”

Asking about price

“How much is this?”

“How much are they?”

“What is the price of...?”

“Can you tell me the price of...?”

Talking about Payment

“Can I pay by credit card?”

“Do you accept credit cards?”

“Can I pay in cash?”

At the end of buying

Phrases:

“I’ll take...”

“I’ll buy...”

“Here is my credit card.”

“Here is the cash.”

Customer: Hello. Is there any fresh bread?

Shop Assistant: Yes, there is. It's on the shelf over there.

Customer: Great. I'll take one loaf. How much is this?

Shop Assistant: It's \$2.50.

Customer: Are there any apples?

Shop Assistant: Yes, there are. They are in the fruit section.

Customer: I'll buy six apples. How much are they?

Shop Assistant: They are \$1.00 each.

Customer: do you accept credit card or cash?

Shop Assistant: Thank you. We accept credit cards. Anything else?

Customer: No, that's all. Thank you!

Shop Assistant: You're welcome!

Customer: Hi. Is there any fresh milk available?

Shop Assistant: Yes, there is. It's in the dairy section.

Customer: Great. I'll take one bottle. How much is it?

Shop Assistant: It's \$1.50.

Customer: Are there any strawberries?

Shop Assistant: Yes, there are. They're in the fruit section.

Customer: I'll buy a box. Do you offer any discounts on vegetables?

Shop Assistant: Yes, we have a 10% discount on all vegetables today.

Customer: Perfect. I'll get some carrots as well. Here is the cash.

Shop Assistant: Thank you. Anything else?

Customer: No, that's all. Thanks for your help!

Shop Assistant: You're welcome! Have a nice day!
