Speaking questions

1. Who is your best friend? Can you tell me about them?
2. What do you like most about your best friend?
3. How often do you hangout with your friend?
4. Can you describe your best friend's appearance?
5. Tell me about your best friend's personality.

Personality: How someone thinks, feels, and behaves.

Appearance: How someone or something looks.

"Behave" means to act or do something.

To ask questions about people

For appearance (looks):

What does he/she look like?

For personality:

What is he/she like?

For job:

What does he/she do for a living?

To describe people and what they are...

You should use **to be** verbs

I **am** kind.

He **is** smart.

She **is** funny.

You **are** a hard-working person.

You can use negative ones too:

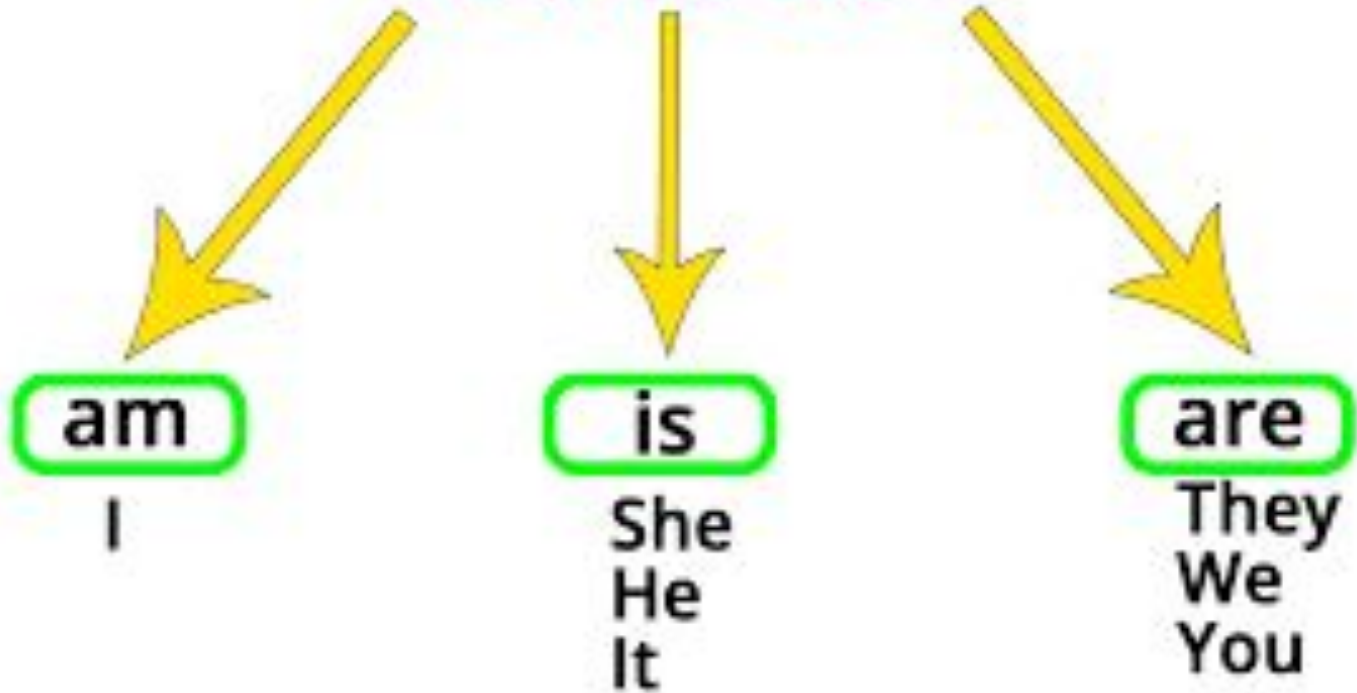
I'm **not** dumb.

He **isn't** mean.

She **isn't** funny.

You **aren't** mean.

To be Verbs



To describe appearance

To describe people's look you need to use **has** and **hasn't got**

Examples:

He **has got** a slim body.

She **Hasn't got** a long hair.

For I/you/we/they,
use **Have** and **Haven't got**:

I **have got** thin lips.

I **haven't got** blonde hair
